

Grade 12 Graduation Bursaries

Cascadia Credit Union (CCU) has up to \$10,000 available to high school students who are planning to attend a Public or Private Post-Secondary approved program. The number of recipients, any regional representation and the amount to be awarded will be at the discretion of the Giving Committee. The deadline to submit your application is April 30th, of the current year.

Bursary Criteria:

- Applicants must provide interim transcript showing proof of credits toward a grade 12 graduation from a recognized secondary school.
- Must be an active independent member of CCU in good standing for a period of 6 months prior to application.
- Must be less than 19 years of age at date of graduation.
- Statement of current community involvement/volunteer time.
- Provide the Committee with a short essay, answering the Credit Union's question (200 words):

“There are many issues in the world today. Please identify an issue that you are passionate about and share how you would make a positive difference at either a local or a global level.”

Completed Bursary applications should be submitted to CCU, to the attention of the Giving Committee by emailing Louise Toth, at ltoth@cascadiacu.com.

The Giving Committee will review all complete applications received by the deadline, taking into consideration all the above criteria. Program approval will be at the discretion of the Giving Committee, all decisions are final.

These bursaries will be paid when proof of registration at a post-secondary institution is provided. These bursaries are only available for eighteen (18) months from the presentation date. Special circumstance may be considered by the Giving Committee, and if they choose to do so the committee may extend the availability period.

Successful recipient(s) will be notified by phone and again in writing; each recipient will be requested to pose for a photo or supply us with a photo for promotional reasons.
